**LAURENTIAN WILDLIFE ESTATE – 2011  
 WAIVER & RELEASE OF LIABILITY – TERMS & CONDITIONS**

<b>WAIVER &amp; RELEASE AGREEMENT</b>	
Please read carefully before signing. This is a release of liability and waiver of certain significant legal rights.	
In consideration for my being permitted to participate in the activities of Laurentian Wildlife Estate, Inc (hereinafter “LWE”), and the use of the hunting property, leased property if any, all vehicles, equipment, services, guides, and facilities, I agree to the following Terms & Conditions, as well as the Waiver and Release of Liability:	
I acknowledge that hiking, fishing, hunting and other related outdoor activities have inherent risks, unknown hazards, and dangers that cannot be predicted or eliminated, particularly in a wilderness environment. I UNDERSTAND THAT THESE RISKS, HAZARDS, AND DANGERS INCLUDE WITHOUT LIMITATION:	
1. Hunting, fishing and other outdoor activities associated with hunting or fishing; 2. The risk of personal property damage, serious injury or death from handling firearms and other weapons, or being in the presence of others that are handling or have in their possession firearms and other weapons; 3. The risk of property damage, serious injury or death from participation in any of the above activities; 4. Injuries occurring by reason of a condition of property (including any condition of any accommodations or other facility or leased property on the LWE hunting property) or activities conducted or circumstances existing on such property; 5. All other injuries, risks and hazards, both foreseen and unforeseen, which are not enumerated above.	
I understand the risks, hazards and dangers described above and have had the opportunity to discuss them with LWE. I understand that these activities may require me to be in good health. I believe that I am in good health and I am able to engage in these activities safely. I understand that I have certain responsibilities, which include, but are not limited to, practicing the above mentioned activities in a safe and responsible manner and refraining from the use of alcohol while practicing such activities. My participation in this activity is purely voluntary. No one is forcing me to participate and I elect to participate in spite of the risks. I AM VOLUNTARILY USING THE PREMISES, PROPERTY, EQUIPMENT, VEHICLES, GUIDES, FACILITIES AND SERVICES OF LWE WITH FULL KNOWLEDGE OF THE INHERENT RISKS, HAZARDS, AND DANGERS INVOLVED AND HEREBY ASSUME AND ACCEPT ANY AND ALL RISKS OF INJURY, PARALYSIS OR DEATH.	
Lastly, I, for myself, my heirs, successors, executors, and subrogees, hereby KNOWINGLY AND INTENTIONALLY WAIVE AND RELEASE, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS LWE, their agents, contractors, directors, affiliates, representatives, employees, officers, insurers and volunteers (hereinafter “Related Parties”) from and against any and all claims, action, causes of action, liabilities, suits, damages, judgments, proceedings and expenses (including attorney's fees of any kind or nature whatsoever) of any kind or nature, which are related to, arise out of, or are in any way connected with my participation in this activity including, but not limited to, acts or omissions or NEGLIGENCE of any kind or nature (whether foreseen or unforeseen) by LWE, its Related Parties, guides, other guests of LWE, LWE’s invitees, trespassers, or animals and livestock of LWE. (including game animals, horses and dogs), which results in any damage, loss, injury, paralysis or death to me or my property as a result of my engaging in these activities or the use of the facilities, animals or equipment. I, myself, my heirs, my successors, executors, subrogees, further agree not to sue LWE as a result of any injury, paralysis, loss, damage or death suffered in connection with my use and participation in the activities of Legacy. I further agree that in any legal action brought to enforce this Waiver and Release Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover expenses relating thereto, including attorneys' fees.	
<b>Terms &amp; Conditions:</b> I understand that as part of my daily rate or package hunt price the following services are included: lodging, guiding, meals, liquor, refreshments, field transport, trophy recovery, quartering and/or de-boning of meat, skinning/caping of head and antlers cut from skull for taxidermist. What is not included as part of my daily rate or package price: any applicable trophy fees, GST (tax on daily rate), airport transfers, meat processing by butcher, polystyrene boxes, taxidermy services, shipping costs related to meat/trophy of any harvested animal, and staff gratuities. (Meat and trophy handling is described separately in “Meat and Trophy Options”). Consuming alcohol in the field is not allowed. Any sign of impact by bullet or arrow shall be constituted as a “kill.” In the rate instance when a hunter wounds an animal, every effort will be made to find the wounded game and recover any edible meat, unspoiled hide and the antlers. I understand all final payments for any remaining hunt fees, trophy fees, non-hunting guests, meat or trophy handling fees, shipping fees or other requested services, shall be due and payable, prior to my departure, at the end of the hunt. (All prices and fees in US Dollars and all monies are non-refundable)

## MEAT PROCESSING AND SHIPPING OPTIONS

The meat from Elk, Stag and Bison at Laurentian Wildlife Estate is extremely good. We take great care in ensuring that it is correctly handled and provide you with several options for your game.

All animals are recovered whole from the field. They are taken to the cleaning facility at the lodge, where they are caped, skinned and quartered. The meat remains in the cooler until your departure.

The average weight of bulls harvested is 750 lbs (range 650lbs-1200lbs). Typically you can work on a 50-55% retention for dressed carcass weight. This usually yields 400-500 pounds of hanging carcass ("bone in"). Typically the meat will fit in 3-4 of our polystyrene boxes (3 - Boneless and 4 – Processed and Frozen). Because hunters have different travel modes and varying tastes for game meat, we offer the following options:

OPTION	COST
• Field recovery of animal, caping, skinning and quartering	No cost
• Take home your meat in quarters – best for your butcher (your own coolers)	No cost
• Take home your meat boneless (your own coolers)	No cost
• Take home your meat quartered or boneless (our sealed polystyrene boxes)	\$50.00
• Have your meat boned out, processed to your requirements, (optional sausage and other specialty meats additional), labeled, vacuum packed and sealed in our polystyrene boxes ready for shipping. <b>(Additional shipping charges apply)</b>	\$375.00

LWE will supply all USFW forms for transport back to the U.S.A. If you are traveling by air or overseas and are unable to take your meat home, LWE can make arrangements for the carcass.

Please check which option you will most likely choose for handling of your game meat:

- Take your meat home in Quarters – Cooler
- Take your meat home Boneless – Cooler
- Take your meat home Boneless – Polystyrene Box
- Have meat processed by Butcher and Shipped – Polystyrene Box
- Not taking meat home - Leave meat with LWE

## TROPHY PROCESSING AND SHIPPING OPTIONS

We handle every trophy with the same care and diligence as the next. We understand that your hunt is not complete, until your trophy is hanging on the wall. Great care is taken to recover animals whole from the field, to avoid damage of antlers and skins. Once again, we have several options for each hunter choose for trophy preparation:

<u>OPTIONS</u>	<u>COST</u>
• Caping and skinning of trophy	No cost
• Freezing of cape/hide for transport – sealed in polystyrene box or your cooler	No cost
• Green Score of antlers (antlers can lose 5% gross in 60 day drying period)	No cost
• Removing Antlers from Skull	No cost
• Preparation of skull for European mount. (cleaning/boiling only)	\$75.00
• Handling and delivery of trophy items to LWE recommended taxidermist	\$125.00
• Crating, paperwork and transport from Lodge to US border for shipping	\$500.00
• All Shipping costs are the responsibility of the hunter and must be prepaid	TBD

- European Mount – No Cape – Antlers Only – Prepped by LWE Staff
- Shoulder Mount – Cape Frozen – Antlers Cut from Skull
- Pedestal Mount – Larger Cape Frozen – Antlers Cut from Skull
- Lifesize Mount – Full Skin Frozen – Antlers Cut from Skull
- Full Skin for Rug (Bison and Bear Only) - Skull Prepped by LWE

## HUNTING GEAR CHECKLIST

- Wet weather gear (jacket and pants). Ensure that this is suitable for hunting.
- Waterproof Hiking Boots. comfortable, properly broken-in prior to the hunt.
- Camouflage clothing: Our forests are mostly a mix of pines and hardwoods. We highly recommend “open” patterns that contrast with shadows and sunrays in the trees. (The leaves usually disappear by the end of October)
- Clothing (Layers)
  - August – Lightweight synthetic shirts and synthetic or cotton pants
  - September – Light fleece, vest or light jacket early morning and late evening
  - October – Fleece or Vest AND Jacket morning/evening (lows 30s-high 60s)
  - November – Tends to be warm mid-days thru mid-month, snow by month’s end
  - December – Fleece or sweater, Heavy jacket, gloves and well-insulated boots
- Binoculars
- Camera (We will also be taking trophy photos for your use)
- Rifle (Minimum .270 Caliber)
  - Sight-in rifles for 100 yards (Very few lanes through trees over 100 yds)
  - Scope should be minimal magnification (Set for 3x-5x while hunting)
  - 1 box of cartridges should suffice
  - Expanding bullets recommended (we discourage solid and ballistic tip ammo)
  - Firearm documentation completed prior to reaching border (Form on Website)
  - Import permit for guns requires a fee of \$50 CDN (no checks)
  - Hunters must visit the LWE range to verify rifle is sighted-in following travel
- Archery (Minimum 50 ft/lbs Kinetic Energy)
  - Proficient to a minimum of 40 yards (practice up to 50 yards if able)
  - 2 and 3-Blade Broadheads recommended (NO EXPANDABLE HEADS)
  - Bring 2-3 practice arrows & broadheads and minimum 2-3 hunting arrows/heads
  - Field points fly different than broadheads, we ask you practice with hunting setup
  - Firearm documentation completed prior to reaching border (Form on Website)
  - There is no Import permit or documentation required for archery equipment
  - Hunters must visit the LWE bow range to verify gear is accurate from travel
  - Gun Import Paperwork and Driving Directions can be found on the LWE website
